1. The individuals listed in attached personnel roster are released from attached units assigned this Hq and attached to the US PD. They are assigned for movement to subject's Separation Center Gps as indicated therein. EDCMR 16 November 1945.
2. Group Leader (and Custodian of Records) is indicated by asterisk (\*) placed before name on attached personnel roster. Group Leaders will be responsible for the proper control, discipline and conduct of all personnel of their respective groups until properly relieved by the CO of a Separation Center.
3. Shipment, consisting of groups listed in subject, above, WP by FAGWaterT and will move o/a 2 November 1945 from this station to a Separation Center in US to be named by individuals to this order by Port Commander at which shipment is debarked for the purpose of Separation under RR and Directives.
4. Stencil #2, for reproduction of movement directives and personnel roster, will be in custody of Group Leaders for delivery to proper authority as US PD.
5. Shipment will be under the control of the CG, ASF, from time of departure from this station until released by proper authority in US.
6. Personnel in this movement will notify emergency addressee, all correspondents and publishers to discontinue mailing letters and publications until further advised, using WD AGO Form 971-1 for this purpose.
7. Per diem is authorized (AR 35-4820)(AR 35-4810) individual within allowances stated by law while traveling only and will not be paid for the time spent at ports, reception station or casual depots.
